



Children's Acceptable Use Policy 2024-2025

- I only use the internet when an adult is with me at home and in school and will try to use devices in shared spaces at home e.g. kitchen/lounge and not in my bedroom.
- I only click on links and buttons when I know what they do. If unsure, I will get help from an adult.
- I will use my school email address to access remote learning if I need to stay at home.
- I will keep my personal information and online passwords safe.
- I will only send messages online which are polite and friendly.
- I know the school can see what I am doing online if I am on a device in school.
- I will not bring any personal electronic devices into school that connect to the internet or have a camera on.
- I know that if I do not follow the rules then my teacher will meet with my parents and I may not be able to use school IT equipment for a set period of time.
- I have read and talked about these rules with my parents/carers.
- I always tell an adult/teacher if something online makes me feel unhappy or worried.

- I will learn about staying safe in school and will follow the SMART rules when I am online both in school and at home.

SMART Rules –

S – SAFE - Stay safe and do not give out personal information online.

M – MEETING - Don't meet people you have met online without telling your parents.

A – ACCEPTING emails, messages or pictures from people you don't know can be dangerous.

R – RELIABLE – information online may not always be reliable.

T - TELL – If someone or something makes you feel uncomfortable or worried tell someone!
