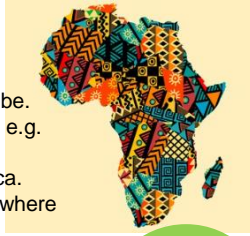




Find where Africa is on a map or globe.

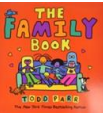
Into the Woods...
