<p>At Manorfield Infant and Nursery School, we value Art and Design as part of broad and balanced curriculum. Children should have experiences that give them the opportunity to express themselves and create artwork that reflects their ideas. Children are immersed in an art and design curriculum that teaches them skills and knowledge that they then revisit, remember and apply by being an 'artist.'</p>	<p>The art curriculum is planned carefully using the National Curriculum and links to termly topics. It is well structured to ensure that children are building on previous skills, knowledge and vocabulary, giving all children the opportunity to be successful. Children will study the work and skills of famous local and well-known artists and designers from different cultures and periods. This work will be used as a stimulus for children to do their own interpretation. In our art curriculum children are given the opportunity to use a range of materials, tools and techniques to create artwork.</p>	<p>Children evaluate their own work throughout the year and progression is looked at across the school. Children are able to talk about artists and designers they have learnt about and skills they developed. Artwork is displayed throughout school so that children can look at each other's work and see a range of skills displayed.</p>
